



PICK 3 GAME CONDITIONS AND PRIZE STRUCTURE STATEMENT

1. RULES AND REGULATIONS

PICK 3 is governed by the Rules and Regulations Respecting Lotteries and Gaming of Western Canada Lottery Corporation (WCLC) WHICH INCLUDE LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY AND ARE AVAILABLE FROM WCLC UPON REQUEST.

2. ISSUANCE OF TICKETS

To participate, a person must present a completed PICK 3 selection slip or request a Quick Pick ticket (where all selections are computer generated) and pay the authorized retailer a \$1, \$2, \$5 or \$10 wager for each PICK 3 selection, per draw. A ticket will be issued showing the draw date(s), the selection(s), the type of play (straight, box or straight/box), the amount wagered, a control number(s) and other relevant information. 1, 2, 5, 10 and 25 consecutive draws can be played per selection slip by marking the appropriate number in the # Draws box and paying the appropriate amount.

3. DRAW

On each draw date, WCLC will cause one 3-digit number to be drawn at random from among all numbers in a field from 000 to 999.

4. WINNING SELECTIONS

Winning Selections in any draw consist of the following:

<u>WINNING SELECTION</u>	<u>CONSISTS OF</u>
Straight Play	An exact match of the three digit number drawn;
Box Play	A match of all three digits of the three digit number drawn, in any order;
Straight/Box Play	A match of the three digits of the three digit number drawn, in any order, (a match in exact order will pay a larger prize).

A selection with the same 3 digits (e.g. 333) is eligible for straight play only. WCLC may, at all times and at its discretion, refuse to issue tickets bearing any selection, as WCLC determines. The aggregate amount that may be wagered on any selection, by any person(s) or at any terminal may be limited by WCLC.

5. WINNING TICKETS

Any valid ticket for any draw bearing any Winning Selection of such draw is a Winning Ticket and entitles its holder(s) to claim, for each such Winning Selection, a prize calculated in accordance with Section 7 hereof. Only one prize per Winning Selection may be claimed.

6. ADVANCE PLAY

If a ticket becomes a Winning Ticket and is eligible for additional draws following the draw date for which it is produced to win a prize, the prize will be paid and a substitute or replacement ticket will be issued for the remaining outstanding draw dates for which it is eligible and the ticket originally produced will, upon issuance of such substitute or replacement ticket, become void.



7. PRIZES

<u>TYPE OF PLAY</u>	<u>PRIZE</u>
STRAIGHT (exact order)	500 x wager
BOX	
3-Way Box (any order)	160 x wager
6-Way Box (any order)	80 x wager
STRAIGHT/BOX	
6-Way Straight (exact order)	290 x wager
6-Way Box (any order)	40 x wager
3-Way Straight (exact order)	330 x wager
3-Way Box (any order)	80 x wager

NOTE: "Way" refers to the number of possible combinations of three numbers in any order. If two numbers are the same (e.g. 1, 1, 2), there are three possible combinations of these numbers in any order (112, 121, 211). If all three numbers are unique (e.g. 1, 2, 3), there are six possible combinations of these numbers in any order (123, 132, 213, 231, 312, 321).

8. PRIZE CLAIMS

Prizes must be claimed in the manner stated on the back of the ticket within one year following each draw date for which the ticket is eligible to win a prize.
